Covid 19 Safety Precautions at the Marina

We are seeing more people coming out to their boats as a place to get out of the house and still stay isolated, especially on the nice weather days. It is important that everyone practice social distancing and hand washing after using the dock carts and restrooms. The #1 issue we see is that people pass on the dock ramps. We have posted "dock ramp etiquette" at the ramps, stressing 1-way traffic only. We also have buckets at the ramps with spray cleaner and paper towels if you wish to wipe the carts. Please take control of your own situation. Stop and wait, step off to the side, wait or whatever you feel will keep you distanced and safe. As we all see in the grocery stores, there are those who abide very well to social distancing and those that do not. You are responsible for your safe distance.

Boat Registrations and Boat Cleaning

Thanks to all those who already cleaned their boats. There are just a couple of really dirty boats with multiple years of dirt are left to be cleaned and we are working directly with the owners. Everyone else, we appreciate you cleaning your boat soon. Winter tarps also need to be off for the summer. Boat registrations are not doing as well. Please get your decals on by June 7th or mail to the office and we will put them on for you. If you have not paid your registration please contact the Marine Board at 1-503-378-8587.

Reminder-nothing is to be left on your boat slip dock, except dock box, power cord and steps. Our staff is instructed to put anything left on the dock back on your boat.

New Ramps Coming

We have ordered new ramps for the middle and lower marina. These new ramps are the exact design as the new ramp at the upper marina. They should be delivered by truck sometime in August. We plan on installing in September. Our plan is to install using a crane from land. Already we have cut the tree at the middle marina to make room for the crane. During the summer we will start preparing the docks at the bases of the ramps. This may involve a day here and there were we have a ramp detour. In the middle marina it will detour to the boatyard ramp and in the lower marina we will pivot the steel dock across the boatlift area to the boatyard ramp. We will post in advance when detours are planned (only mid-week between 9am and 4pm)

Marina Office Open but Closed

The marina will continue to be staffed to answer phone calls and handle fuel sales. We are restricting access inside the office. Payments and paperwork can be put in the drop box to the left of the office door. The delivery companies continue to put packages in the dock box on the porch of the clubhouse. UPS and FedEx, who have regular drivers, typically go direct to the homes.

Summer Hours

The office will be staffed 7 days a week, Monday- Friday 9am-5pm and Weekends 10am-5pm. These are the same hours for the fuel dock. There are fuel purchase procedures posted on the pumps. Do not come into the office. Very limited sales of snacks and only when fueling.
