We will have a large banner sign posted at the top of the hill for all trucks to stay up on the hill and call the marina office who will send a staff up to get the delivery. If a contractor shows up with a truck they will need to walk down the hill with their tools to your home.

Boat Trailers and Trailer Boats

Boats planning on leaving by Oct 1st should plan on a Delay

We realize many trailer boats pull out of the water at the end of September. Because the trailers are stored and we are not allowing trailers on the new asphalt until Oct 8th- We will not charge any of these people for any October moorage provided they are out of the water by October 31st.
