



Common Sense Rules and Summer Etiquette Reminder

As the summer boating season starts, we wanted to refresh everyone on the safety rules and common-sense etiquette. We want all our residents and tenants to have a safe and enjoyable summer.

- Remember that there are dozens of full-time floating home residents here who call this their home all year long. Keep your guests from making noise on the docks. Once out on the water yell all you want.
- You are responsible for your guests. They need to have a parking permit and park in guest parking areas.
- No running on the docks.
- Kids 12 and under *must* wear life jackets on marina docks - we have loaner kid sizes in a dock box outside the office.
- No charcoal barbecues in the marina. No barbecues of any kind on marina docks.
- No Fire Works
- If you are taking off for many days, consider parking your car away from the ramp area.
- Remind your guests not to flush items into toilet/sewer system that have not been eaten
- No swimming in the marina. There is potential for lethal stray electrical current

- Do not walk around without a shirt on.
- Quiet hours 10pm to 9am. Do not use noisy power tools after 6pm.
- Bring docks carts back to ramp area for others to use. Do not use black dock carts for batteries, fuel cans, heavy items, construction debris, etc. The black carts are for food, clothing, and other clean items. There are heavy carts and hand trucks for the heavy and dirty items or fuel cans or engine parts.
- No smoking on the docks. If you see someone, please ask them to put it out.
- No painting or sanding on your boat exterior.
- Do not leave hazardous waste in the garbage areas. No oil, propane cans, old gas, paint, etc.- Its yours-take it to Metro.
- Do not overflow the garbage or cardboard dumpsters, especially in the upper marina on the weekends. If possible, hold your trash until Monday or put in the storage area at top of ramp and we will put in dumpster when there is space
- Watch your speed in the parking lot- more people in the summer walking
- Watch your boat wake in front of marinas
- Restrooms- clean up after yourself
