Covid

Parking Lot Security

Annual Fire Extinguisher Inspection- Friday March 31st

All house and marina fire extinguishers will be inspected by our service. The marina pays the \$8 charge. If you have extra extinguishers in your house put on your front porch. You will be charged \$8 for the extras. Boaters can also have their extinguisher tested, please bring them to the office prior to March 31. You will be billed \$8 per extinguisher.
