Winter Hours

We are closed on Monday January 1, 2024

Our normal winter hours in the office and fuel dock are Monday-Friday 9:30 to 5pm.

We remain closed on the weekends until the first of May.

Prepare for Winter

Boats- We have already had 1 boat sink, and another almost sink from rainwater. Make sure your tarps are secure, scuppers are clear and that you have a functioning bilge pump. Shut your seacocks and winterize your boat systems by draining and/or antifreeze. Use a heater with a freeze protection thermostat so it only goes on at freezing temperatures.

Floating Homes- Have an emergency supply of water and food, flashlights, a way to charge your cell phones, a supply of salt at your front door and whatever else you might need if we lose power (no power means no water too) or get snowed or iced in. Snow shovels will be put out if snow is expected.
